Sauvignon Blanc 2018

#76359 | \$144 \$120/3

Pale straw color with a juicy mid-palate. Delicious tropical, bright melon and citrus notes combine with a lovely fresh, mouth-watering acidity. The flavor and expression was carefully preserved by way of cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks.



Pinot Noir

#76360 | \$180 \$160/3

Full of bright berry fruit flavors, a hint of spicy oak and is wonderfully smooth. Vibrant, fresh and balanced with a lingering finish.

#67659 | \$104 \$72/3

Brilliant pale yellow in color with greenish highlights. Mineral notes are complimented by aromas of white flowers, mango, melon and even grapefruit. The same notes can be found on the palate, joined by a lively acidity and a persistent finish.



Castell Chardonnay 2018

#76249 | Six Pack | \$52 \$33.50/5

Bright yellow color with aromas of melon, peach and nectarine. Very good balance between volume, acidity and length. Citrus and tropical notes.



Rosada Rosé 2018

#76251 | \$120 \$104/3

70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Tempranillo
Bright pale pink. Aromatically subtle with elegant strawberry notes. Soft floral touches are reminiscent of grapefruit with a light undercurrent of anise. A friendly entry denotes a great deal of volume and a pleasant texture, giving the wine a long finish



Boira Garnacha 2016

#76353 | \$104 \$80/5

A pleasant rich entry with supple tannins on the palate. Intense sensations of black fruit with supple notes of cocoa and balsamic nuances. A licorice finish with a touch of aniseed.



Pirinenca Tempranillo 2016

#67660 | \$104 \$72/5

Intense ruby red in color, this wine is very fresh with spicy notes of nutmeg and pepper along with traces of anise. This wine has great structure on the palate with sweet and supple tannins that lend a pleasing mouthfeel. Aromas of ripe black and red fruit intermingled with notes of cocoa and spices with a sweet finish.

Abadia Cabernet-Tempranillo

#76503 | Six Pack |

\$52 \$33.50/5

Intense cherry red with purple hues denoting its youth. Complex aromas of ripe dark fruit and stewed prunes with notes of tobacco, set against a spicy background (pepper, clove, vanilla) and hints of dark chocolate. Well-structured thanks to the power brought by the Cabernet yet with finesse and elegance, owed to the Tempranillo. Red and dark fruit flavours in the mouth, with a sweetish touch. Long aftertaste with a pleasant, spicy finish.

65% Tempranillo, 35% Cabernet Sauvignon

Deep, purple-red color and a nose of ripe, dark berry fruits with hints of dark chocolate and vanilla oak. The full and silky palate reveals layers of juicy ripe berry fruit, dark chocolate, and a touch of sweet oak on the finish.

70% Chardonnay, 15% Parellada,

Brilliant yellow colour with green reflections and fine, persistent bubbles. Citrusy and tropical fruit notes in the nose along with more complex ageing aromas of toast and brioche. The palate is creamy and long lasting.

Delicate cherry color with strawberry tones and fine, persistent bubbles. Aromas of red fruit, strawberries, cherries and woodland fruits with hints of green apple. Elegant and light on the palate. Well balanced between acidity and sweetness with a refreshing finish.

40% Macabeo, 30% Parellada, 20% Xarello, 10% Reserve Wine

Very pale straw yellow in color with elegant, fine bubbles. On the nose, typical varietal aromas of citrus and almond flower are prominent. A pleasant, fresh and well balanced sparkler on the palate.



Clasico Cava Brut Rosé

The rosé version of the traditional clasico cava. A Brut with a fresh and very fruity aroma, made from the traditional varieties Monastrell, Grenache and Trepat.

Fresh, easy to drink and balanced. Fragrant in the nose with red fruit and notes of anise. Intense and refreshing.

54% Grenache, 29% Cabernet Sauvignon,

15% Carignan, 2% Syrah

Crisp and brilliant in color. A deep ruby red with garnet and bluish hues on the rim. Intense lingering aromas of red and black fruit, wild strawberries, blackberries, floral notes of violet intermingled with subtle spicy and toasty hints. This wine is full bodied with finesse and a silky midpalate. Ripe and elegant tannins are overlain with mineral aromas from the limestone soil.

Garnatxa 2017

#67673 | Six Pack | \$90 \$80/2


This vintage yielded a fresh wine dominated by red fruit notes. Cherry red in color with bluish hues that denote its youth. Aromas of ripe red berries with underlying mineral hints. Red berries reappear on the palate with a rounded mouthfeel. A balanced wine with lots of fresh fruit.



Cartoixa 2014

#67672 | Six Pack | \$240 \$200/2

A deep to very deep, cherry red with violet hues. Intense lingering aromas of ripe black fruits, plus a floral hint of violet intermingle with prominent mineral notes. Spicy notes come from its aging in oak. On the palate it is robust, buttery, supple with intense mature tannins, fully rounded body and a long lingering finish.

Blanco 2017

70% Viura, 30% Malvasía

#76487 | Six Pack | \$60 \$54/3

A pale yellow with slight greyish steel hues. A rich aromatic bouquet. Notes of white fruit, citrus and fennel with a light toastiness from aging in oak. A supple, fresh and balanced mouthfeel.

#67675 | Six Pack | \$90 \$80/4

A deep cherry red with an intense ruby rim. Elegant with a floral bouquet and notes of red fruit underlain with sweet spices (vanilla) and roasted coffee. Persistent, exhibiting the balance of great Riojas.

Rosado 2017

70% Garnacha, 30% Viura

#76488 | Six Pack | \$24

Brilliant with a pale pink tone. The nose is subtle, with reminiscences of strawberry, raspberry, violet flowers and spiciness (aniseed, chamomile) A structured buttery entry that gives it length. The wine's acidity adds freshness and balances its structure on the palate.

Gran Reserva 2011

90% Tempranillo, 10% Graciano

#67692 | Six Pack | \$180

Garnet and cherry hues introduce this bright Gran Reserva with light orange reflections on the rim. A complex, elegant nose with notes of liquorice and redfruit, typical of the Tempranillo, along with hints of spices subtly added by the Graciano. Toasty and balsamic aromas (vanilla, pepper, tobacco). As the wine is aired in the glass, it displays a full range of nuances and complex aromas. The mouth has a sense of elegance and balance, ending in long persistence.

Crianza

#76504 | Six Pack | \$67 \$54/3

Sweet cherry color with some violet notes. High aromatic intensity; flowers, red fruit and black licorice with hints of vanilla and coffee. The palate is smooth, balanced and fresh with good structure and soft tannins.

Verdejo 2017

#76261 | Six Pack | \$42

Intense on the nose, with a floral bouquet and notes of white fruit intermingled with faint herbal hints. Lots of body on the palate with along finish and the characteristic bitter aftertaste of the Verdejo varietal.

Crianza 2015

97% Tempranillo, 3% Cabernet Sauvignon

#67671 | Six Pack | \$104 \$88/3

Very intense cherry red with violet hues. The nose shows ripe black fruit blended with the toasted and spiced nuances from barrel aging. On the palate it shows great breadth and persistence on the finish. This wine has excellent cellaring potential. One year barrel aging in oak (half French, half American, 25% new).

Intense, cherry with violet hues. Black fruit and licorice aromas mix with subtle notes of violets and jasmine. Hints of toasted vanilla. Robust and well-structured with rounded tannins.
